

Whistle-Blowing Policy

In my role as a child minder, I have a duty to report unacceptable behaviour:-

- By other childminders
- By childcare workers
- By other professionals working with children to the relevant authorities.

This action will be necessary when:-

- The behaviour is detrimental to children.
- Has placed a child at risk.
- Has caused actual harm to a child.
- Is clearly illegal.

In these situations, I may be required to contact any of the following:-

- Police
- Social Work Service
- Ofsted
- Any other relevant body and pass on the information known to me or to inform of events that I have witnessed.

I am also required to notify Ofsted if I become aware of persons who are childminding without being registered.
